Just outside Taunton at Hillcommon is our farm. We grow seasonal British flowers in 2 acres of flower fields and polytunnels.

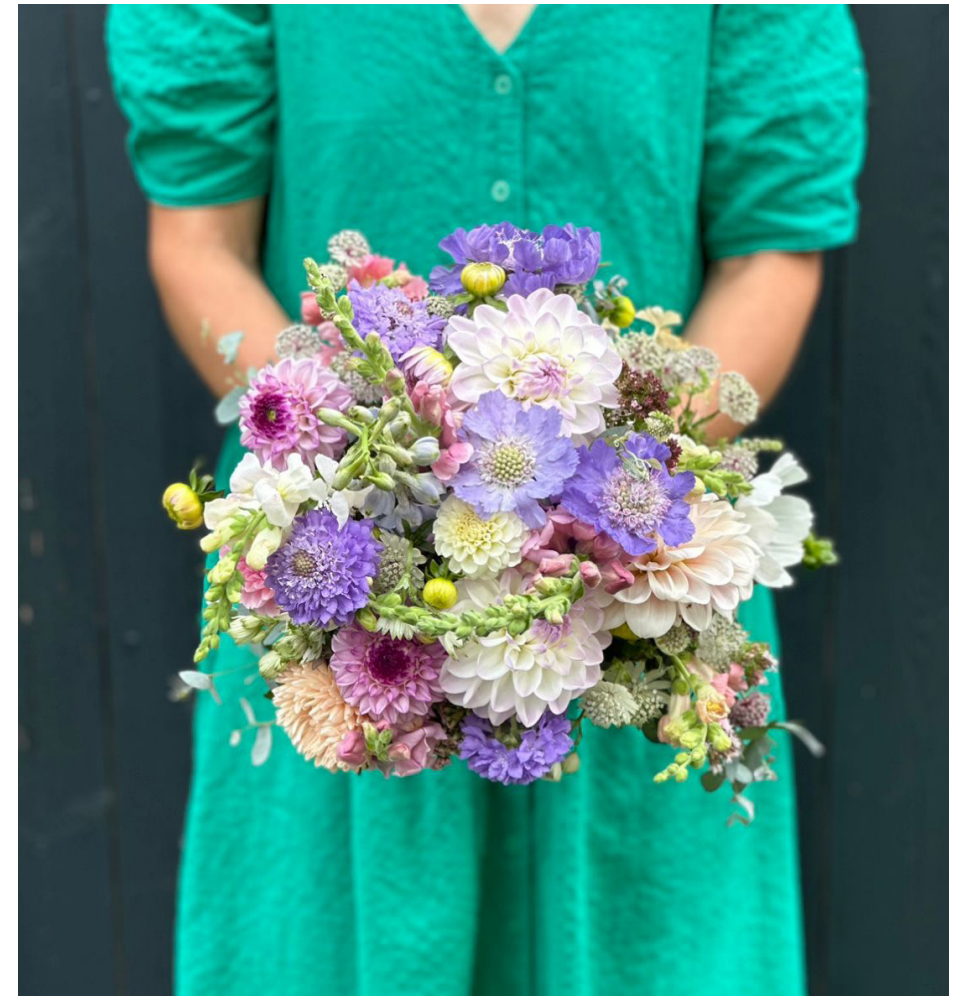
OUR COMMUNITY

We grow our beautiful flowers for florists, weddings, and local flower lovers. We propagate annuals, biennials and perennials and grow them into plug plants for fellow growers (both large and small) locally and nationwide.

SUSTAINABILITY & QUALITY

We have a sustainable approach to everything we do. Our flower farm is off grid, using solar power for our flower fridge in the summer and propagating benches in the winter. We are proudly free from air miles, floral foam, chemicals and single use plastic. Our flowers are all propagated from seed or cuttings on site and we create our own compost to improve our soil each year.

We care about the details, from providing stunning flowers to building lasting relationships with our customers.



We grow a huge variety of flowers and foliage for weddings. They are unique, seasonal and garden fresh. Sustainability is at the forefront of our practices, working naturally and chemical free. This allows us to offer a very bespoke service.

MEET THE GROWER

Founded in 2017, The Flower Tree is Nicola's Somerset flower farm - a place shaped by her hands, her patience, and her love of growing. Spread over more than two acres, the fields are alive with flowers and wildlife, without chemicals and with deep respect for the land.

Every stem, is grown and nurtured by Nicola herself, full of scent, character, and a fleeting beauty that only truly fresh flowers have. The season begins softly in February with anemones and ranunculus, and carries on until November, when chrysanthemums bring the year to a gentle close. In between, the fields hum with bees, colour, and quiet magic, always offering a reason to wander in and fall a little bit in love.

Nicola founded The Flower Tree in 2017, growing flowers and foliage across more than two acres of Somerset land, both in open fields and under gentle cover. From March to November, she works closely with the rhythm of the seasons, nurturing a carefully chosen collection of annuals, biennials, perennials, and shrubs, all selected for their beauty as cut flowers.

Spring

We handpick flowers from our five acre farm to perfectly reflect your colour palette.

Your flowers and foliage will naturally work in harmony with the season of your wedding to capture the floral moment, from the froth and delicacy of early spring to the rich, warm fruits of autumn.

Our growing season begins in March, when the tunnels and fields start to come alive. Spring bulbs, anemones, and show-stopping ranunculus bloom in a wonderful array of colours. The orchard is washed in blush-pink blossom, while tender green perennials start to emerge.

Ordering your flowers

In the week of your wedding, Nicola will select the very best flowers growing at The Flower Tree, chosen in your colour scheme, pastels, brights or whites. As we work with seasonal flowers, we do not promise specific varieties; each design reflects what is growing at the time. Please see our seasonal guide for an indication of what is typically in flower during each season.

Laura will then create your bridal flowers, carefully designed using the selected blooms. Bridal party designs include bridal bouquet, bridesmaid bouquets, flower girl posy, buttonholes and corsages. Your flowers will be ready for collection either the day before or on the day of your wedding.

To get started, simply let us know your wedding date, colour scheme, collection date, and how many designs are required. All dates are subject to availability. Once your date is secured, we'd love to see any inspiration photos you'd like to share.

If you would like to discuss ceremony or venue flowers, please let us know and Laura will be happy to discuss this with you.
